



Frances Mary Lewis

July 30, 1924 - January 27, 2017

Frances M. Lewis of Townsend, DE, formerly of Millington, MD, died Friday January 27, 2017, at the Christiana Hospital Center in Newark, DE. She was 92.

Mrs. Lewis was born in Matoka, WV, the daughter of the late Mark and Macy Foley Bowden.

After her son was school age, Lewis returned to finish her senior year of high school, then went to college to attain her Degree in Education and continued her college career by attaining her Master's Degree in Business Education. Mrs. Lewis began teaching in 1965 and in the fall of 1966, after moving to Millington, she began her career teaching Business at the new Queen Anne's County High school, Centreville, MD, where she remained until her retirement in 1984. Mrs. Lewis was a Life Member of the Church of God, and when her health allowed, attended the Life Focus Center in Middletown. For many years, Mrs. Lewis enjoyed quilting and ceramics as hobbies, but the love of her life was her family.

In addition to her parents, Mrs. Lewis was predeceased by her husband, Tate E. Lewis, in 1986; two sisters, Helen Bowyer and Pauline Lewis; and six brothers, Ira, Bennett, Tracy, Mark, Jack, and Chester Bowden.

She is survived by one son, Tate E. Lewis, Jr., and his wife, Denise T. Lewis, of Townsend, DE; and a grandson, Tate Francis Lewis of Townsend.

Funeral services will be held on Saturday February 4, 2017, at 2:30 p.m. in the Fellows Family Funeral Home, 370 Cypress St. Millington, MD, where friends and family may call after 1: 30 p.m.

Interment will be held in the Crumpton Cemetery, Crumpton, MD.

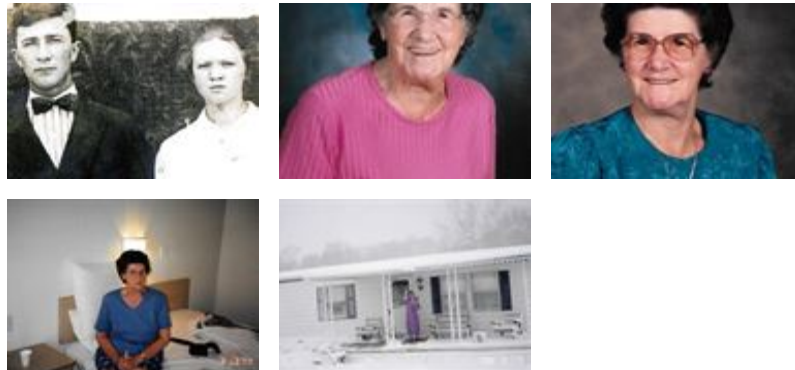
