



Frances Atwell Money

April 6, 1918 - December 26, 2012

Frances Atwell Money, 94, of Kennedyville, MD, died on December 26, 2012, at Golden Rule Assisted Living Home in Rock Hall, MD.

Mrs. Money was born on April 6, 1918, in Kennedyville, MD. She was the daughter of the late Oliver and Nellie Jones Atwell. She graduated from Chestertown High School in 1935. She married George Albert Money in 1937. They lived on a farm in Kennedyville until Mr. Money's passing in 1950.

In 1951, Mrs. Money went to work for People's Bank in Chestertown as a bookkeeper, retiring in 1986. Mrs. Money was a life-long member of Kennedyville United Methodist Church, serving over 50 years as church financial secretary. She was also a charter member of the Kennedyville Volunteer Fire Company Ladies Auxiliary.

In addition to her husband, Mrs. Money was preceded in death by her sisters, Virginia A. Timko and Mary A. Hill, and a brother, Allan Atwell.

Mrs. Money is survived by her daughter, Joyce Money Jacobs and husband, Thomas E., of Kennedyville; a granddaughter, Nicole Jacobs; brother, G. Clifton Atwell; and sisters, Dorothy A. Pinder and Margaret A. Miller, all of Kennedyville.

Funeral services will be held on Saturday, December 29, 2012, at 1 p.m. at Kennedyville United Methodist Church where relatives and friends may call two hours prior (11 a.m. -1 p.m). Interment will be in Chester Cemetery following the service.
