



## Frances Lambeth Reynolds

December 1, 1914 - August 13, 2018

Frances Lambeth Reynolds of Chestertown, MD, died on Monday, August 13, 2018, at Heron Point in Chestertown. She was 103.

Born on December 1, 1914, in North Carolina, she was the daughter of the late Rev. William Allen Lambeth and Evelyn Walker Lambeth. She earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Mathematics from High Point University in Greensboro, NC. She toured Europe before embarking on married life. On July 7, 1937, she married Hal Kearns Reynolds. They made their home in Bryn Mawr, PA, where they raised their family.

Mrs. Reynolds was involved in volunteer work with Baldwin School, Bryn Mawr Hospital, and Bryn Mawr Presbyterian Church. She and her husband built their summer home in Quaker Neck in 1958. Her husband predeceased her in April of 1993, while a resident of Heron Point.

She was involved in the Garden Club. Mrs. Reynolds is a member of St. Paul's, Kent in Chestertown. She enjoyed natural gardening and yardwork. Her secret to her longevity was positive thinking.

She is survived by a daughter, Jane Sharrow of Elkton, MD; five grandchildren, Benjamin Sharrow, Jennifer Dumin and husband Nels, Frederick William Sunderman, III, and wife Katie, Elizabeth Sunderman, and

Emily Sunderman and husband Michael; and six great grandchildren, Lauren Dumin, Will Sunderman, Chloe Sunderman, Hailey Hauck, Caitlin Hauck, and Carter Lee. She was predeceased by a daughter, Carolyn Sunderman. in 2011.

A memorial service will be held Wednesday, August 22, 2018, at 11 a.m. at Wesley Hall at Heron Point in Chestertown, MD.

Interment will be held in St. Paul's Cemetery at a later date.
