November 5, 1931 - November 30, 2019

Frances Theresa Yoos of Chestertown, MD, died on November 30, 2019, at University of Maryland Shore Regional Medical Center at Chestertown. She was 88.

She was born in Baltimore, MD, the daughter of the late John and Edna Portman Kramer and raised in Augsburg Lutheran Home until her early teens. She married Robert Louis Yoos on January 24, 1959.

Mrs. Yoos worked with Ray's Envelope in Baltimore, and she and her husband made and sold covers for the beds of trucks. She was primarily a homemaker raising and caring for her family in Baltimore where she was a member of Gray Manor Lutheran Church. She and her family moved to Chestertown, MD, in 2000. She enjoyed cooking, reading, crocheting, and watching British movies. She was devoted to her family and adored her grandchildren. Her husband predeceased her on March 23, 2011.

She is survived by her children, Terry Lynn Yoos and Robert Albert Yoos (Juli) both of Chestertown, MD, and three grandchildren: Ryan M. Yoos, Ian G. Yoos, and Amber Guy.

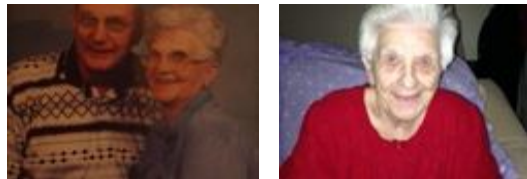

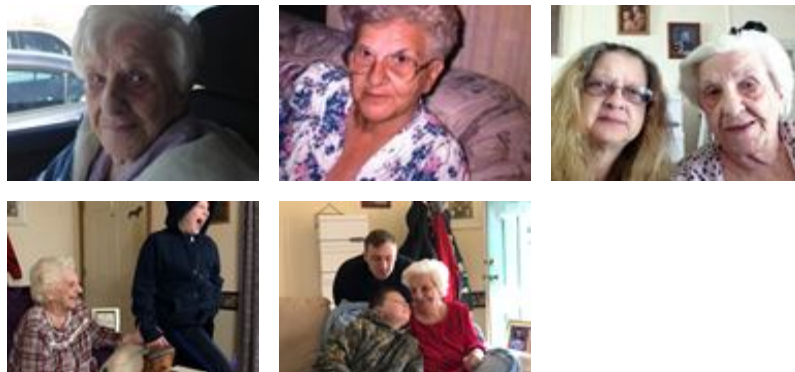

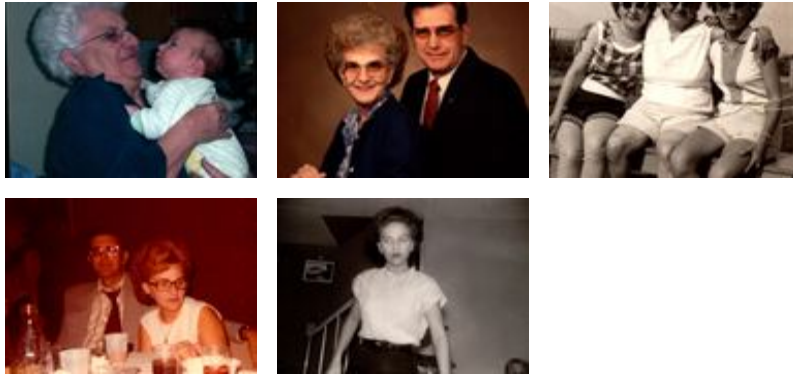
