



## Frances A. Ashley

CENTREVILLE: Frances A. Ashley of Centreville died at at her home on March 15, 2002. She was 72 years old. .

Born in Centreville on April 13, 1929, she was the daughter of the late Claude Bennett and Frances Eleanor Butler Anthony. After graduating from Centreville High School in 1946 she then received her degree from the University of Maryland in 1950.

She worked at the Dept. of Social Services in Annapolis before returning to Queen Anne County to teach. At her retirement she was working for the Queen Anne County Dept. of Aging.

Mrs. Ashley was a Charter Member of the Queen Anne County Historical Society and the Museum of Eastern Shore Life. She served on the Kent-Queen Anne County Adult Guardianship Review Board and was a member of the Chester River Association and the Auxiliary of the Memorial Hospital in Easton and a former member of the Board of Elections Supervisors. She was a member and Past President of the Queen Anne's County Democratic Women's Club and a member of the Centreville United Methodist Church. In 1986 she was the first woman to be elected to the Board of County Commissioners. In 1998 she was elected Judge of the Orphan's Court in Queen Anne's County.

Mrs. Ashley is survived by two sons, John M. Ashley III and Philip A. Ashley and his wife, Ann, and one grandson. A brother, Claude B. Anthony, Jr. and a sister, Doris A. Taylor are deceased.

Funeral Services will be held at the Centreville United Methodist Church, Centreville MD at 11:am Tuesday March 19,2002. Internment will be at Chesterfield Cemetery immediately following funeral services.
