Frances Annalee Coleman of Trappe, MD died Wednesday, October 31, 2001 at the home of her niece, Rosalie Price. She was 85.

Born December 2, 1915 in Trappe, she was the daughter of the late Samuel H. and Rosa Lee Saunders Wheatley. After graduating from Trappe High School in 1934, she married Earl Christopher Coleman on December 11 of that year. She worked at various places in the Trappe area and in 1963 became a nurse's aid at Easton Memorial Hospital, where she remained until 1973. Mr. Coleman died September 24th of this year.

A member of the Trappe United Methodist Church, she was a Sunday School Teacher for the nursery class for several years before becoming the Head Greeter for the church. A Life member of the Trappe Vol. Fire Co. Ladies Auxiliary, she served as Secretary from 1958 to 1960 and then became the fifth auxiliary President from 1960 to 1962.

Mrs. Coleman is survived by one daughter, Ellen C. Whitby of Trappe; three grandchildren, James A. Whitby, Jr., Leslie S. Whitby and Michael D. Whitby; four great grandchildren, Tara L. Whitby, Amber N. Whitby, Hunter D. Whitby and Kaylee N. Whitby and several step grandchildren. Mrs. Coleman had raised several foster children.

Services will be held on Monday, November 5, 2001 at 11:00 AM at the Trappe United Methodist Church where friends may call one hour prior to the service. Burial will be at Woodlawn Memorial Park, Easton.
