Frances Carter Pyle died on Wednesday, April 22, 2009 at the Hospice of Queen Anne's Hospice Center in Centreville. She was 79 years old.

Born in Centreville on July 18, 1929, she was the daughter of the late, Francis Bennett and Margaret Troy Carter. She graduated from the Centreville High School, Class of 1946. She married Edgar L Pyle, Jr. of Chestertown on July 30, 1949. They made their home in Chester in 1958. Mrs. Pyle worked part-time as a proofreader for the Maryland State Legislature for over 15 years.
