A Mass of Christian Burial for Frances G. Tracey of Easton, MD will be celebrated on Wednesday, December 22, 2004 at 10:00 AM at St. Joseph's Catholic Church, Cordova, MD. Mrs. Tracey died at Corsica Hills-Genesis Eldercare, Centreville, MD on Sunday, December 19, 2004. She was 86.

Born November 30, 1918 in Talbot County, she was the daughter of the late Howard and Lida Dill Gannon. On January 28, 1939 she married Donald H. Tracey, Sr. and they made their home in Taneytown. In 1960 they moved to Hillsboro. Mr. Tracey died in 1965. The family then moved to Easton. Mrs. Tracey was a switchboard operator at the Memorial Hospital for a year and a secretary for Mt. Pleasant Elementary School for many years.
