A Funeral Liturgy for Frances Prettyman Detrich will be celebrated at Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic Church in Easton on Saturday, March 31, 2001 at 10 AM. She died on Thursday, March 29, 2001 at William Hill Manor. She was 85.

Born November 8, 1915 in Easton, MD, she was the daughter of the late Charles W. and Eva James Prettyman.

For more than twenty years she was the Talbot County Representative for WCEM in Cambridge. She had also served as secretary for the Easton Downtown Merchants Association for many years.

A charter member of the Jr. Auxiliary of the Memorial Hospital at Easton and Ladies of The Elks, Mrs. Detrich was very involved in civic and fund raising activities in the community, especially for the Sts. Peter and Paul School and Memorial Hospital. Although a very helpful and community oriented person, who enjoyed gardening, nothing could ever exceed her love for her grandchildren.
