MEEHAN, Francis Alan, 93, of Easton, MD, formerly of Baltimore, passed away peacefully November 18, 2023 surrounded by his loving family.

Beloved husband of the late Joan Adams Meehan and devoted father to his four children, Michael (Bonnie) Meehan of Salisbury, MD., Patrick Meehan of Easton, MD., David (Nickol) Meehan of Draper, UT., and Elizabeth (Bruce) Braunewell of Amber, PA., as well as his six grandchildren, Kathryn, Stephen (Emma), Daniel (Lauren), Emily, Zachary and Brody. Mr. Meehan is also survived by Janet Dwyer of Easton, MD., with whom he found love later in life.

Mr. Meehan was a wonderful brother to his siblings, (late) Robert, Denise (Fulco), Carroll and Joseph.

A sales representative for Uniroyal and Stride Rite for 39 years, Mr. Meehan served as a member of their clothing advisory board responsible for developing new products. In 1958 he was transferred to the Eastern Shore, a place he and his family dearly loved and called home. He enjoyed traveling, the beach and playing golf, but is best remembered for his talent as a harmonica player.

Mr. Meehan attended Loyola High School and College where he was active in

basketball and track, becoming state high jump champion for Loyola High School in 1948. When polio cut his athletic career short in 1950, Meehan spoke about the impacts of the disease and need for a cure on behalf of the March of Dimes.

Mr. Meehan was deeply loved by his family and touched by all who knew him. His 93 years were not near enough and he will be forever missed.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated December 6, 2023 at 11 am at Saints Peter and Paul Catholic Church in Easton, MD., with visitation beginning at 10 am. Private interment at Saint Joseph's Church in Cordova, MD.
