Francis Gilpin Bartlett, Jr. of Easton died at home on January 12, 2005. He was 79.

Born in Baltimore on September 19, 1925, he was the son of the late Francis Gilpin Bartlett and Ruth Murray Bartlett. He was the grandson of The Rt. Rev. John Gardner Murray, the first elected Episcopal Bishop of the United States and his wife Clara Hunsicker Murray and the grandson of Gen. John Kemp Bartlett, former attorney General of the State of Maryland and his wife Mary Garrett Dixon Bartlett. He was a graduate of the first class of The Country School in Easton and St. Paul's School in Baltimore. After St. Paul's School, Mr. Bartlett entered in to the U. S. Army and was in the medical corps during World War II. After the war, Mr. Bartlett joined his father's business "The Bartlett Realty Company" in Easton and continued with its operation until his retirement. He married the former Sara Hundley on November 5, 1955.

He was a member of The Chesapeake Bay Yacht Club. His passion in life was sailing, fishing, automobiles and visiting Nova Scotia.

He is survived by his wife and eight nieces and nephews and seventeen great nieces and great nephews. He is predeceased in death by a brother, John Gardner Murray Bartlett and a sister Alice Bartlett Lane.

Memorial Services were held at Christ Church Easton on January 15, 2005

and Burial will be at the convenience of the family.
