



## Francis "Franny" B. Toy

October 6, 1936 - January 7, 2010

Francis B. "Franny" Toy, Jr. of Chestertown, Maryland died at home on January 7, 2010. He was 73.

He was born in Wilmington, Delaware on October 6, 1936 the son of the late, Francis B. Toy, Sr. and Margaret Barron Toy. A graduate of Wilmington High School Class of 1954. He worked with Electric Hose and Rubber in Wilmington until their closing when he started a tax preparation and accounting service. In April of 1976 he married Nancy McGinnis and they resided in Chestertown, MD.

Mr. Toy worked as bookkeeper and office manager at Pardoe's Tree service as well as opening his tax preparation and accounting service in Chestertown. In 1987 he started Toy's Outdoor Store in Rock Hall and operated the business until his retirement in 2007. An avid hunter and fisherman, Mr. Franny also worked as a hunting guide for many years. He also hunted most of the United States and Canada. He enjoyed reading, playing cards and gab sessions with friends. He and his wife were fortunate to have enjoyed traveling extensively. Mr. Toy was a Revolutionary War buff and an accomplished Revolutionary War figurine and diorama artist.

Mr. Toy was preceded in death by a sister, Margaret Toy and a brother, Edward Toy.

In addition to his wife Nancy he is survived by children, Debbie Petka and her husband, Bill of Hockessin, DE, Franny Toy III of Smyrna, DE, Stephen Toy and his wife, Margaret of Wilmington, DE, Stephen Goins and his wife, Anina of Churchton, MD, and Teresa Goins Rose and her husband, Don of West River, MD; 11 grandchildren and 1 great grandchild.
