Frank M. Butler of Chestertown, MD died Wednesday February 16, 2005 in the Chester River Hospital Center, Chestertown, MD. He was 78.

Born in Manhattan, NY, he was the son of the late, Edward and Helen Morris Butler. He attended All Hallows High School, Bronx, N.Y. and graduated from the University of Maryland. He also attended George Washington University School of Law. Mr. Butler was a WWII Army veteran serving in the European arena.

Mr. Butler retired in 1998 as the owner and President of J.W. Worthington Co.

He was a member of the Chester River Yacht and Country Club, where he enjoyed playing golf and traveling with his MISGA friends. He was also a member of the Chestertown Optimist Club, the Chestertown Lions Club, and the American Legion. For many years Mr. Butler enjoyed coaching Little League basketball.

Mr. Butler is survived by his wife of 53 years, Mary Joan Butler; three sons, Dr. Kevin Butler of Tarpon Springs, FL, Dr. Brian Butler of Houston TX and Michael Butler of Atlanta, GA and six grandchildren.

In addition to his parents, Mr. Butler is predeceased by one brother.

A Memorial Mass will be offered at the Sacred Heart Catholic Church, Chestertown, MD on Friday February 25, 2005 at 11am.

Interment will be at 11 a.m. on Saturday February 26, 2005 in the Lorraine Park, Cemetery, Baltimore, MD.
