



## Frank William Crowther

January 6, 1949 - September 27, 2022

Frank William Crowther passed away peacefully at home surrounded by family on September 27, 2022. He was 73 years old.

Frank was born on January 6, 1949, in Northampton, Massachusetts, to the late Frank Wilson Crowther and the former Bernice Germain.

After graduating from Northampton High School in 1967, Frank enlisted in the U.S. Air Force and honorably served his country for four years from August 1968 to August 1972. He was last stationed in Oklahoma City and worked for Honeywell for a few years before returning to Massachusetts. He attended college in Springfield and became a Civil Engineer working for Conrail and CSX in Management for the Railroad Industry. His career eventually took him to Maryland in the year 2000. After retiring from the railroad, he then was offered employment by the Federal Government as an Inspector of Track, working for 15 more years in his field before retiring in 2018.

Throughout his life, Frank enjoyed boating and taking his family and friends out on the water to fish and swim, first on the Hudson River in New York, and more recently on the Chesapeake Bay. After retirement he enjoyed working on restoring his '66 hot rod pick-up truck.

Along with his parents, Frank was predeceased by his sister, Barbara Holland,

of Springfield, MA.

He is survived by his beloved wife of 53 years, Sandy Crowther of Stevensville; son, Peter (Amy) Crowther of Smithfield, VA; daughters, Stacey (Michael) Connelly of Centreville, MD, and Jaclyn (Dennis Krack) Crowther, of Goldsboro, MD; ten grandchildren; and one great-grandchild. He is also survived by two brothers, Gilbert and Geoff Crowther; two sisters, Cynthia Halsey and Janice Hoffman; and several nieces and nephews.
