



## Frank Duxbury

December 1, 1913 - June 14, 2011

Frank L. Duxbury of Chestertown, Maryland died on June 14, 2011 at home. He was 97.

He was born in Ogallala, Nebraska on December 1, 1913 the son of the late, John C. and Lucy A. Bandon Duxbury. A graduate of Greenly High in Greenly, Colorado in 1932 he enlisted in the U.S. Navy in 1934. Mr. Duxbury served during World War II in the South Pacific and was honorably discharged with numerous campaign medals in 1945.

On December 22, 1938 he married Mae Louise Davis. She predeceased him in 1984.

Following his discharge in 1945 he went to work for SEPTA as a bus driver in Philadelphia, PA. He retired in 1976 and he and his wife moved to their summer home in Tolchester.

Mr. Duxbury enjoyed fishing and gardening. He was a member of the Frank M. Jarman American Legion Post #36 in Chestertown, Maryland.

He is survived by a son, John Duxbury and his wife, Alice of Drexel Hill, PA; two daughters, Helen Louise Marston and her husband, Claude of North Carolina and Elizabeth Ann Love and her husband, Lenny of Earleville, MD and 13 grandchildren. He is also survived by six great grandchildren and one great great grandchild as well as his loving friends, Carol and Blair Galt.
