



## Frank Frohn

September 16, 1922 - January 15, 2013

Frank Frohn of Stevensville, Maryland (formerly Baltimore County) died on Tuesday, January 15, 2013 at the Hospice of Queen Anne's in Centreville, Maryland. He was 90.

Born on September 16, 1922 in Baltimore, Maryland, he was the son of the late John Frohn and Ernestine Miller. He married his wife Mary on February 26, 1943, while he was in the Navy and stationed in Florida. He served in North Africa during WW II in 1943 and 1944. Upon his return, a printer by trade, he was employed by International Paper at their Lord Baltimore Press Plant in Baltimore, and later for the Sherwin Williams Company. He thoroughly enjoyed the warm out of doors, and fishing and crabbing were his greatest pleasures, especially on the Eastern Shore. He was an outstanding card player, and spent many hours with his friends and family playing cards and teaching his skills.

He was preceded in death by his loving wife Mary, with whom he shared almost 70 years of married life. Frank is survived by his two sons, Frank William Frohn and his wife Donna of Stevensville, and William John Frohn and his wife Ruth Ann of Perry Hall; four grandchildren, Bill Frohn, Greg Frohn, Joyce Peach and Marie Burkman; four great-grandchildren, Allyson and Samantha Frohn and Dominic and Taylor Burkman. He was preceded in death by his four sisters: Pauline Simmons, Anna Frohn, Marie Tyree, and Fannie

Bennington; and his two brothers, William Frohn and Edward Frohn.
