Frank Edward Gary, Sr., 73, passed away on Friday, September 19, 2014, at the University of Maryland Shore Medical Center in Easton of pancreatic cancer. He was born in Dearborn, MI, on February 15, 1941, son of Lewis and Virginia (Casebier) Gary.

After a successful career in heavy equipment and computerized machine tool sales, Frank left corporate life in 1988 to start a business in yacht sales, including Petrini Yacht Sales and Bristol Yacht Sales. He transitioned to Walczak Yacht Brokerage Service in Annapolis in 2006. His vast product knowledge of power and sailing vessels made him the “go to broker” for those in the know and a guide and mentor to many in the industry. Among his many accomplishments, Frank was past president of Yacht Brokers Association of America and served on their Ethics Board. He was a licensed Florida Yacht Broker and an active member of the Florida Yacht Broker’s Association. He also served on the Board of Marine Trades Association.

Frank is survived by his loving wife, Regina (Conlin); four children, David Gary (daughter-in-law, Laurie Bataglia) of Nags Head, NC, Melanie Cooksey of Indianapolis, Frank Gary, Jr. and Schuyler Gary; one granddaughter, Allie Ferraro of Indianapolis; a brother, Gerald Gary (Shirley); and sister, Marlene Lewis, both of MI; and several nieces and nephews.

A memorial service will be held Monday, September 29, 2014, at 11 a.m. at Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic Church, Easton, where he is a member.
