Frank was like any other young man, love for life, friends, music and outdoors. He made many good choices and he made some bad choices that changed his life forever.

His family tried to help him win the battle of addiction through many interventions, rehabilitation, support and love. We will always love and miss him.

Tom Bond, Director of Programs at The Helping Up Mission, remembers him this way, "Frank was a singular force of nature. One of the funniest, most intelligent, and naturally gifted guys I've ever known, and I was proud to call him friend. Frank only had one speed - full tilt. He danced on the edge of destruction for many years and cheated the angels time and time again. If you knew Frank, you know about his struggle; the same battle many of us wage every day; the same disease that is claiming our friends and family on a daily basis. Frank's battle is over, and though deeply saddened, I pray his soul is

finally at peace. He will be greatly missed.”

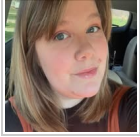
