



Frank Bellinger May

November 29, 1921 - May 4, 2016

Frank Bellinger May died on Wednesday, May 4, 2016, at the University of Maryland Shore Medical Center at Easton. He was 94.

Born November 29, 1921, in Flushing, NY, he was the son of the late Frank Newton May and Margherita Bellinger May. After graduating from The Grange in Santiago, Chile, he attended Princeton University where he received a B.S. in Mechanical Engineering in 1943. He received further education at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology.

On April 30, 1943, he married the former Mary Josephine Hundley.

Having been commissioned as an officer in the U.S. Navy in 1942, he remained on active duty until 1946 when he entered the Navy Reserves, which he remained a part of until his release in 1963 as a Lt. Commander. In 1946, he and his wife moved to Honolulu, Hawaii, where he became a salesman and structural engineer for Lewers & Cooke Limited. In 1952, he became an executive for Master Builders Company, headquartered in Cleveland, OH. While working for the company, he lived in various countries such as Japan, Belgium, Germany, Canada and England. In 1974, he moved to Upper Saddle River, NJ and became the President for Penn Dixie Chemical Company in New York, NY. He retired in 1978 and moved to the Wye River in Queenstown. In 1996, he and his wife moved to Easton.

Mr. May's wife, Mary, died in 2013. Mr. May met Margaret Berry, who had moved to Heartfields from Chapel Hill, NC. They were married shortly thereafter. Their union was the subject of a TV broadcast which highlighted newlyweds at the age of 90 plus. Both would say their time together was brief by full of joy.

Mr. May was a member of the Miles River Power Squadron and the Poplar Island Yacht Club.

He is survived by his wife, Margaret, three sons; Frank Bellinger May, Jr. of Denville, NJ, Keith Hundley May of Red Bank, NJ and Kenneth Newton May of Bozeman, MT, a sister Suzanne Joyce of Sonora, CA; so grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.

A service will be held at a later date.
