Frank James McClyment of Bethlehem, MD, went home to be with God on Tuesday, July 8, 2014, at his home with his loving family by his side. He was 51 years old.

Frank was born in Chestertown, MD, on January 16, 1963. He was the son of the late James McClyment and Judith Emala Whitby of Preston. He attended elementary school in Centreville and then Colonel Richardson High School in Federalsburg. He worked for Howard Coleman and Archie Sinclair for 10 years performing tree service. He was a handyman for 20 years until he became disabled.
