



## Frank R. "Randy" Wallace

May 5, 1963 - September 13, 2011

Frank Randall "Randy" Wallace of Easton, MD, and formerly of Fort Worth, TX, died at his home in Easton, on Tuesday, September 13, 2011. He was 48. Born in Corpus Christi, TX, he was the son of the late Paul Wallace and Sharon Hull Mellard of TN.

Mr. Wallace graduated from the University of Loyola in Los Angeles, CA with a BA degree in Film and Television. He was the former owner of Randall's Café in Fort Worth, TX. He was a former member of the Fort Worth Jaycees, a volunteer with the Ronald McDonald House in Fort Worth as well as the Sanquinity Cancer Camp for Kids. He also volunteered with the National Brain Tumor Association in Washington, DC.

Randy was formerly employed as an agent with Champion Real Estate in Easton, MD, and at the time of his death, was a partner with Whitney-Wallace Real Estate Company in Salisbury, MD. He was a member of Tidewater Camera Club in Easton and also the Chesapeake Film Festival.

In addition to his mother, Mr. Wallace is survived by his loving wife, Ellen Troutman-Wallace of Easton, whom he married in 1997; two sons, Dane Randall Wallace and Reed Clark Wallace, both of Easton; his maternal grandmother, Evelyn Hull; a brother, Trey Wallace; and a sister, Stephanie Mayo, all of Tennessee.
