Frank J. Scherber of Grasonville, MD, age 88, passed away peacefully of natural causes on October 24, 2017, in Centreville, MD.

The son of Francis A. Scherber and Edith M. Scherber, he was born on October 16, 1929, and raised in Niagara Falls, New York. He was a graduate of Niagara Falls High School.

Frank was a devoted husband to his wife, Shirley A. (Mackenzie) of 57 years and a loving father to their children. He is survived by his daughters, Debbie A. Lyman (Scott), Terry L.
