



Frank Stone

December 6, 1927 - September 29, 2014

Frank Ernest Stone of Wittman, MD, passed away on Monday, September 29, 2014, at William Hill Manor. He was 86.

He was born on December 6, 1927, in Frankford, PA, the son of the late Frank E. Stone and Gladys Russell Stone. He was preceded in death by his wife, Emma Stone, and a brother, Russell Stone.

Frank served in the United States Army in the European Theatre of Operations during the end of World War II. He was a long time commercial waterman; crabbing, tonging, and fishing the waters of the Chesapeake Bay. Frank was the last surviving crew member of the 75 ton catch of fish that occurred in 1951. This catch was the largest recorded that has occurred on the Chesapeake Bay to date.

Mr. Stone is survived by his children, Joyce Crow (Robert) of Tilghman, MD, Lila Kalnajs (Andrejs) of Madison, AL, Francine Wooters (Holton) of Easton, MD, Frank Stone (Mitzi) of Hurlock, MD, and Grace Stone (Chip) of Wittman, MD; six grandchildren; 11 great-grandchildren; and a sister, Dorothy Cummings of Easton, MD.

A funeral service will be held at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home P.A., 200 S. Harrison St. in Easton, Maryland on Wednesday, October 8,

2014, at 11:00 a.m. A visitation will be held on Tuesday, October 7, 2014, from 6:00 – 8:00 p.m. at the funeral home.

Interment will be in Woodlawn Memorial Park on Route 50 near Easton.
