



## Frank Allan Thomas

August 9, 1944 - March 3, 2012

Frank Allan "Al" Thomas of Denton, MD, died on Saturday, March 3, 2012, at Memorial Hospital in Easton, MD. He was 67.

Born August 9, 1944, in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of the late, Frank William and Margaret Virginia Deale Thomas. He graduated from Catonsville High School in the Class of 1963. He then attended the University of Maryland and Dale Carnegie School of Business. On February 13, 1965, he married the former, Ellen Kerger of Catonsville, MD. In 1976, they moved to Chester, MD. Mr. Thomas worked at Standard Brands, selling food items; S.T.P. as regional sales manager and later at Bob Smith Automotive as Cadillac Sales Manager. He taught sales at St. Joseph's University in Philadelphia, PA, and he started Chesapeake Produce and ran it for five years in Chester, MD.

He was past president of the Kent Island Rotary, first president of the Kent Island Youth Soccer League, Supreme Knight of Regina Coeli Council; Beta Lambda Gama Sigma Fraternity. He was a member of St. Peter and Paul's Catholic Church and past member of St. Christopher's Catholic Church.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Thomas is survived by two sons, Chris Thomas and his wife Kristen of Chestertown, MD, and Mark Thomas and his wife Christine of Bel Air, MD; three brothers, Kenny Faggio, Anthony Faggio, and Terry Faggio, all of Baltimore, MD; a sister, Carol Usher of Brunswick, GA; and four

grandchildren, Matthew Thomas, Makaila Thomas, Tristan Thomas and Taylor Thomas. He was pre-deceased by a sister, Joy Schwartz.

Memorial Mass will be held at St. Christopher's Catholic Church on Friday, March 9, 2012, at 11 a.m.
