



Frank H. Shultz, Jr.

July 12, 1922 - April 11, 2010

Frank H. Shultz, Jr. died on Sunday, April 11 at the Memorial Hospital at Easton after a long battle with cancer of the liver. He was 87.

Born in Washington, D.C. on June 12, 1922, he was the son of the late, Dr. William Gray and Constance Shultz. He grew up on Brook Farm in Chevy Chase, MD. He graduated from Augusta Military Academy and VMI in Lexington, VA. He entered the Army in 1943 and landed at 11:00 a.m. at Omaha Beach on D-Day and fought in the invasion of Normandy. He subsequently fought in the Battle of the Bulge and every major battle in the European theater in the 1st Army Division known as the Big Red One. He came back after his service in 1947, and settled in Chevy Chase, MD. He worked as a residential developer and real estate broker for Bogley Real Estate and Long and Foster. He moved to the Eastern Shore of Maryland in 2000.

He taught professional waterskiing in Cypress Gardens, FL and then in Maryland on the Chesapeake Bay. He was a long-term member of the Chevy Chase Country Club and the Metropolitan Club of Washington.

Mr. Shultz is survived by his son, Frank Shultz, III of Oxford, MD, and a cousin, Billy (Rozella) Shultz of Orlando, FL.
