Charles Franklin Davis of Chestertown, MD, died on Thursday, July 19, 2012, at Springwell Senior Living Community in Baltimore, MD. He was 82.

Frank was born on October 28, 1929, in Chestertown, MD. He was the son of the late, William Ensey and Carolene Bryan Davis. Frank attended Chestertown High School and graduated in 1946. He attended Washington College for a while but had to leave to help support his family. In 1959, Frank married his wife, Antonia B. Davis. He began farming in the 1960's a vocation that he enjoyed throughout his life. He retired after 42 years as a Regional Supervisor of Road Construction with the Maryland State Highway Administration.
