Franklin Archibald Dick of Chestertown, MD died on Friday, March 7, 2003 at Kent & Queen Anne's Hospital, Chestertown, MD. He was 89.

Born on December 10, 1913 in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Mr. Dick attended the Lawrenceville School and Princeton University. He was a chemical engineer and successfully registered a patent for a testing system used in the printing ink industry. He spent the first 25 years of his career with the Interchemical Company and then worked for Converter's Ink. During retirement, he served as President of Marbetech, Inc. until his death. A veteran of World War II, he served in the United States Army Air Force, 368th Fighter Squadron, in the European theater.

Mr. Dick was pre-deceased by his wife, Marjorie. He is survived by his two daughters, Marjorie Anderson of Amelia Island, Florida and Elizabeth Smith of Boston, Massachusetts; three grandsons, George Cooper of Arlington, Virginia, F. Cullen Cooper, of Greensboro, North Carolina and William Cooper of Winston-Salem, North Carolina; a sister, Mai Dick West and his two half-brothers, Edward A. Griffith and William L. Griffith, all of Baltimore, Maryland.
