Franklin D. Middleton, formerly of Rock Hall, MD, died on April 17, 2018, at The Heartland House in Grasonville. He was 86.

Born on January 21, 1932, he was the son of the late Howard Erdman Middleton and Frances Price Matthews. Mr. Middleton served in the United States Army from 1955 - 1957. After his honorable discharge, he began his career at Wilson Feed, which later became Southern States of Centreville.
