April 22, 1932 - December 5, 2015

Frank D. Smith of Crumpton, MD, died on Saturday December 5, at the University of Maryland Shore Medical Center at Easton. He was 83.

Mr. Smith was born in Hope, MD, the son of the late Roland and Annie Buckle Smith. Mr. Smith worked in construction for the James Julian Construction Co. for many years and during his career, he built his own home. 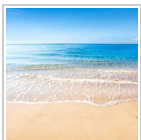
