



## Frank Powell Wrightson III

Frank Powell Wrightson, age 72, died on Friday, August 18, 2006. He lived most recently in his birth town of Easton, Maryland.

Powell grew up in Easton where he met and married his high school sweetheart, Harriet Dise, in 1954. He graduated from the University of Maryland with a B.S. in Physical Education and a Masters in Education. Powell and Harriet moved to Montgomery County Maryland where they raised their 4 children; he taught at both Leland and Wood Junior High Schools and ran a very successful gymnastics program.

During the summers, Powell and a partner ran a travel camp for boys; their travels took them all over the Eastern and Midwestern states as well as into Canada. Later, he owned and operated a summer canoe-tripping camp for boys in Northern Ontario, Canada, on Lake Temagami—his favorite spot on this earth. Powell sold the camp in 1978 but continued to teach and run his gymnastics program. He retired from teaching in 1988 and continued to enjoy summers at Lake Temagami through this past July.

Dad or “Grandan” is survived by his loving family members: son Steve, his partner Terri, and their children Katie and Mark; daughter Terri and her partner Susan Johnson; daughter Leslie (Hubbard) and her partner Dennis; and Powell’s dog, Missy. He is preceded in death by his son Alan (1998) and his

precious wife Harriet (2002).
