



## Frank Robert Stamm Jr.

Frank Robert Stamm, Jr passed away on Sunday, January 6, 2008 at Easton Memorial Hospital. He was 81.

Born on August 2, 1926 to the late Frank R. Stamm, Sr. and Mary E. Glesmer in Baltimore, MD. Frank grew up in Dundalk, MD where he attended school. At a young age, he joined the United States Army, serving with the 147th Infantry Regiment in the Asiatic-Pacific Theatre of Operations. While enlisted he inspected, maintained, and performed repairs to gasoline powered motor vehicles and examined vehicles for defects and making the appropriate repairs. In 1946, after being honorably discharged, Frank returned to work for Thompson Lincoln and Mercury as a painter in the body shop. He later worked for the Patapsco & Back River Railroad, first as a fireman, then as a co-engineer, and finally as an engineer. On September 24, 1955, he married Dorothy May Thomas. They moved to Stevensville, MD in 1974. He retired as an engineer from Patapsco & Back River Railroad in 1986. From 1986 to 2000, he ran Stamm Lawn Services which proudly served Anne Arundel and Queen Anne's Counties.

He was a past Exalted Ruler at the Kent Island Elks Lodge #2576, member of the Kent Island United Methodist Church and the American Legion 278, Edgemere and Bay County Moose Lodge in Queenstown, MD. He loved cars and boats.

Frank is survived by his loving wife, Dorothy M. Stamm of Stevensville, MD; two daughters, Donna Streckfus and her husband, Tim of Cordova, MD and Karen Taylor and her husband, Rick of Stevensville, MD; son, Frank Robert Stamm III and his wife, Helen of Stevensville, MD; five grandchildren, Frank Robert Stamm IV, Kristina Stamm, Ricky Taylor, Jr, Tim Streckfus, Jr, and Sean Taylor.
