Easton resident Fred Horton Johnson died on November 20, 2022, at the age of 86.

Mr. Johnson was born in Knoxville, TN, on September 25, 1936, to Dudley and Freddie Johnson. They moved to southern Maryland, where they were loggers in rural Calvert County. Fred graduated from Calvert County High School in 1955. Looking to branch out in the lumber business, Mr. Johnson purchased the small lumber company on Longwoods Road in 1972 and Johnson Lumber Company, Inc., was established. At that time, Fred and his family settled in Easton.

He was a member of the Easton Elks Lodge #1622 for 53 years and the Moose Club for 49 years.

Along with his beloved wife of 66 years, Frances, he is survived by a son, Alan Johnson and his fiancé Jeanne Bryan and her daughter Taylor; and a daughter Donna Johnson, of Easton; his siblings, Betty Gould of West Palm, FL, and Claudette Howlin (Bobby) of Grasonville, MD; and one grandchild, Abigail Johnson (Trystan).
