January 27, 1925 - December 24, 2008

Fred H. Siegel, 84, a 22-year resident of Prospect Bay in Grasonville, died of pneumonia December 24, 2008 at Anne Arundel Medical Center.

Mr. Siegel was born in Brooklyn, New York in 1925 to Martin and Rosalyn Siegel. He graduated from Abraham Lincoln High School in Brooklyn. He enlisted as an aviation cadet in the Army Air Corps and served in the South Pacific during World War II as a bombardier on B-29's flying out of Saipan. He received the Distinguished Flying Cross and the Air Medal. He married Madeline Polk in 1946 and they were happily married for 62 years. He graduated from Bethany College in 1949 and had his own accounting practice in Great Neck, New York. He continued to serve in the Air Force Reserves and retired as a Lieutenant Colonel in 1985.

Mr. Siegel enjoyed golf, swimming, traveling and spending time with his family.

He is survived by his wife, Madeline; two daughters, Shellie and her husband, Ross and Susan and her husband, Gary and three grandchildren, Ashley, Adam, and Greg.

Services will be held at 1:00 PM, Sunday, December 28, 2008 at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., 106 Shamrock Road, Chester, MD. Mr. Siegel will be interred at Arlington National Cemetery.
