Frederic A. Otterbeck “Fred” died on Sunday, October 23, 2016, at the University of Maryland Shore Medical Center at Easton. He was 77.

Born on July 18, 1939, in Brooklyn, NY, he was the son of the late Frederick and Margaret Sohm Otterbeck.

Fred married the former Maryann Agnitsch on February 13, 1965, in Amityville, NY, and they resided in Sayville, NY, for 31 years before moving to Trappe, MD, in 2002.

Fred’s lifetime love of the water began growing up in Massapequa, Long Island, NY. At an early age, he started clamming which led to his life-long career and hobby as a commercial fisherman.
