



## Frederick Herbert Heinbokel

July 26, 1919 - May 14, 2013

Frederick Herbert Heinbokel, 93, of Easton, MD, died on Tuesday, May 14, 2013, at Heartfields in Easton.

Born on July 26, 1919, in Scranton, PA, he was the son of the late John F. Heinbokel and Erna Gartner Heinbokel.

Mr. Heinbokel graduated from Dartmouth College in 1942. After graduating from college, he joined the U.S. Army, serving in the Infantry. He fought courageously in the Battle of the Bulge. He later received his MBA from the Tuck School of Business at Dartmouth. His entire career was with Armstrong World Industries, retiring in 1986.

He is survived by a son, John Heinbokel (Lynn) of Barboursville, VA; a daughter, Harriett Riter (Charles) of Easton; and one granddaughter, Amanda Gallegos (Zachary) of Cockeysville, MD. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Janet Scott Heinbokel.

A memorial service will be held at a later date in Lancaster, PA.
