The Chesapeake center was created, and Freddie became a client, and took great pride in the various types of work he was engaged in. He made many lifelong friends and companions there, and was always welcomed back for a visit, well after his "retirement."

He was surrounded by a large and loving family on both his maternal and paternal side, all of whom helped Freddie become the very special person he was. Since 1977, he was in the care of Harry Johnson's granddaughter, Linda Loveland Blizzard, of Cordova, daughter of the late Ruby Johnson Loveland, and Linda's late husband, William Blizzard.
