Frederick Kastel of Easton, MD, formerly of St. Michaels, died on Thursday, May 8, 2003 at Genesis Eldercare-The Pines, Easton. He was 88.

Born June 23, 1914 in Baltimore, he was the son of the late Fritz and Anna Fischer Kastel. After attending public school he worked in photolithography at Tin-Decorating Company in Baltimore and then, during World War II in Washington, DC as the Section Chief of the Camera Division of the U.S. Coast and Geodetic Survey. In the mid 1950's he moved to St. Michaels where he worked in Voshell's Boatyard. He later purchased the business and operated it as the St. Michaels Boatyard and Marina until the sale of the business in the 1970's.

While living in St. Michaels he was a member of Granite Masonic Lodge and the St. Michaels Rotary Club. He was a member of Trinity Cathedral in Easton, where he has lived since 1985.

Mr. Kastel is survived by his wife, the former Daisylea Carl Hobbs, whom he married in Baltimore in June 1939; two sons, Timothy Kastel and his wife Marsha of Bozman, Byron "Barney" Kastel and his wife Candice of St. Michaels; a half-brother, Walter Spindler of Clearwater, FL; two grandchildren Ryan Kastel, T.K. Kastel and his wife Kimberly, and three great-grandsons Carter, Kyle and Connor.

Funeral services will be private.
