August 7, 1926 - January 11, 2017

Frederick William Schultz of Grasonville, MD, formerly of Stevensville, MD, died on Wednesday, January 11, 2017, at the age of 90.

Born on August 7, 1926, in Baltimore, MD, the son of the late Frederick and Mildred Knighton Schutz. He grew up in Baltimore and attended Baltimore City College High School. He enlisted in the Navy and served in WWII as a Navy Airman. After his service in the Navy, he returned to Baltimore and married the late Sarah Cecelia Krueger in September of 1946. He worked as a letter carrier for the U.S. Postal Service until he retired in 1979. They resided in Baltimore until 1978, when they made their home in Stevensville, MD.

Mr. Schultz was a devoted reader of military history, sports, and politics and never missed a Colts, Ravens or Orioles game on TV.

He is survived by his loving son, William Dwight Schultz, and his wife Wendy of CA; a granddaughter, Ava Schultz of CA; a brother and Lindsley Schutz of Cincinnati, OH; and nephews David and Stephen Schutz. He was predeceased by his beloved wife, Sarah Cecelia Schultz, in 2013.

and friends may visit with the family one hour before.

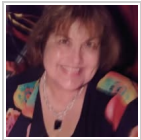
