Frederick K. Thornberg of Chestertown, Maryland died on March 20, 2005 at Chester River Hospital Center in Chestertown. He was 80.

Born in Fulton, NY on April 27, 1924, he was the son of the late Fred V. and Gladys Kelley Thornberg. He was a 1942 graduate of Fulton High School and completed one year at Syracuse University before serving in the U.S. Army. He served from April 12, 1943 until March 11, 1946 in the Asiatic Pacific Theatre during WWII.

After an honorable discharge he returned to Syracuse University where in 1951 he received a bachelor degree in Architecture. While attending Syracuse he was a member of Sigma Phi Epsilon Fraternity. In 1949 he married Phyllis Dean. They resided in Syracuse NY and relocated to Summit, NJ where they raised their family. In Summit he was Chairman and a member of the Building Code Board of Appeals and served on the New Jersey Board of Easter Seals Society. He also was a member of the Beacon Hill Club.

Mr. Thornberg worked as an industrial architect with various architectural firms, notably Corbett, Thornberg, Stetchow, and Jordan in Newark, New Jersey. He was a member of the American Institute of Architects.

In 1988 he and his wife moved to Chestertown, Md where he was a member of Emmanuel Episcopal Church serving as Junior Warden, and a member of Chester River Yacht and Country Club. He enjoyed traveling and model railroads.

In addition to his wife of 55 years, he is survived by a son, Frederick Dean Thornberg of Centreville, MD; a daughter, Ann T. English of Sandwich, MA and eight grandchildren.

Services will be held on Thursday, March 24, 2005 at 2:00 P.M. at Emmanuel Episcopal Church. Interment will be in St. Paul's Cemetery.
