Frederick C. Murphy of Cambridge died on Sunday, December 9, 2001 at his home. He was 68.

Born on September 27, 1933 in Cambridge, MD, he was the son of Frederick and Eleanor Windsor Murphy. He graduated from Cambridge High School in the class of 1952. Mr. Murphy started working for Dupont Corporation in Seaford, DE when he was drafted and served in 1953 in the U. S. Army serving in the Korean Conflict. On October 26, 1957, he married Phyllis Carroll of Secretary, MD. Mr. Murphy started working for the Department of Natural Police in 1959 and moved from Rock Hall, MD to Queen Anne's County where he served until 1988. He was named Marine Police of the Year in 1970. Mr. Murphy enjoyed crabbing and golfing. In 1991 he moved to Secretary, MD and enjoyed taking winters in Fort Meyers, FL.

He was a member of the Fraternal Order of Police Lodge #16. Mr. Murphy was a member of the Kent Island United Methodist Church, and attended the Sunny Side Alliance Church.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Murphy is survived by one son, Glen Carroll Murphy and his wife Jennifer of Stevensville; and seven grandchildren, James, Michael, Monica, Jacob, Molly, Mary Beth and Toby Murphy. He was predeceased by a daughter, Melanie Carol Murphy on October 17, 1985.

A memorial service will be held 11:00 AM on Saturday, December 15, 2001 at Sunnyside Alliance Church, Secretary. Burial will be private.
