Frederick Howard Edwards of St. Michaels died on Sunday, April 3, 2011 at William Hill Gardens. He was 83.

Born on November 24, 1927 in Bayonne, NJ; he was the son of the late Frederick H. and Vera Twaits Edwards. After serving in the United States Navy, Mr. Edwards graduated from Syracuse University. At the time of his retirement, he was the Vice President at Compressed Gas, Inc. in Pinebrook, NJ.
