Frederick John Schnell, died Saturday, Sept. 9, 2000 at Anne Arundel Medical Center. He was 76.

He was born May 27, 1924 in Curtis Bay, Maryland, and raised in Baltimore City by Albert and Helen Murphy Brazil. Mr. Schnell joined the U.S. Navy in 1941, and served until 1967.
