Frederick Levi “Ted” Weller of Easton, MD died on Wednesday, February 27, 2008 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. He was 99.

Born October 4, 1908 in Holley, NY, he was the son of the late Levi Hiram and Elizabeth Mary Shaw Weller. After graduating from Holly High School in 1927, he attended Hobart College in Geneva, NY and later Stetson University in DeLand, FL. On June 11, 1937 he married the former Lula May Sinclair. They made their home in Tilghman, MD until moving to Easton in 1985. In 1943 he entered the U.S. Army and received an honorable discharge in 1945 as a Corporal. He worked for the State of Maryland Employment Service until 1971. Mrs. Weller died December 29, 2005.

He was a Past Master of Granite Lodge A.F. & A.M. #177 of St. Michaels, a member of Boumi Temple in Baltimore, B.P.O. Easton Elks Lodge #1622, American Legion Post # 70, and at the time of his death he was the oldest member of the Tilghman Volunteer Fire Company.

Mr. Weller is survived by his sister, Ruth Ann Howeth and her son, William Frederick Sinclair; a niece, Dr. Barbara Wonderly and her husband Dr. Donald Wonderly and their son, Hugh; and several great nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by a brother, Edwin Weller who died in 1971.

Funeral services will be held on Saturday, March 8, 2008 at 11:00 AM at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton, MD. The family will meet with friends at the William Hill Manor Auditorium following burial at Woodlawn Memorial Park, Easton.
