Frederick Lewis Ferriero, of Ridgely, died at his home on Sunday, April 8, 2001. He was 70.

Born in Harrison, N.J., May 27, 1930, he was the son of the late Joseph and Jennifer Ferriero. After attending public school, he worked in New Jersey in the warehouse and heavy equipment operation industry.
