Frederick R. Waldmann of Hillsboro, MD died on March 9, 2004 at Caroline Nursing Home, Denton MD. He was 86

Born on August 8, 1917 in Lansdowne, Maryland on a farm, he was the youngest of seven children. He was the son of the late George and Lena Ruth Waldmann. He attended Catonsville High School, and on August 20, 1938 he married Catherine Reese of Baltimore. Mr. Waldmann served in the U.S. Navy in the Pacific, Atlantic and Indian Oceans during WWII. After the war, he was a plumber with a gas fitters license and worked for Ingleside Plumbing & Heating Co. in Catonsville, and later Southern Mechanical Co. of Baltimore. He retired in 1969 and moved to the Eastern Shore. Mr. and Mrs. Waldmann lived in Stevensville, Woolford, and in 1986 moved to Queenstown.

Mr. Waldmann was a member of the Kent Island American Legion Post #278, a life member of the Grasonville VFW Post #7464, and a member of the Bay Country Moose Lodge #831 in Queenstown.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Waldmann is survived by three daughters, Joyce Ann Carlson of Chester, Linda Marie Waldmann of Annapolis and Carol Lynn DiFatta of Hillsboro; four grandchildren and four great grandchildren.
