Fred T. Barstow of Chester, MD died on Monday, December 27, 2010 at John's Hopkins University Hospital.

Fred was born in Delaware to the late, Frederick T. and Mary E. Crane Barstow. He grew up in Washington, D.C. He attended Linten Hall in Manassas, VA and later attended St. John's High School in Washington D.C. Fred started out working for T.W.
