September 17, 1946 - August 25, 2024

Gary Edward Clough, 77, of Cambridge, MD, died Sunday, Aug 25, 2024, in Baltimore, MD following a lengthy hospitalization and a seventeen year battle against the effects of exposure to Agent Orange.

He was born in Albany, NY in 1946 to Joseph and Dorothy Clough. Gary graduated from the Albany Academy as Captain in 1965 and attended the University of Denver prior to enlisting in the U.S. Navy in 1967. In 1970, Gary completed a one-year assignment with the Brown Water Navy in Binh Thuy, Vietnam. He returned from the war to complete his education at Rosary Hill College in Amherst, NY earning a BS in Business and Economics. Gary was the owner of Future Builders Supply, Inc. in Hurlock, MD, and a long-time supporter of the local community sponsoring high school extra-curricular and athletic activities, and volunteering as a member of the American Legion Post No. 243 and Veterans of Foreign Wars Federalsburg Post 5246.

He is survived by his wife of 50 years, Kathleen Lennon Clough; his children: Julie Lennon Griffin (Sean) of Kingston, NY, Gavin Hughes Clough (Cerra) of Leesburg, VA, and Catherine Elizabeth Clough (Steven Salay) of Buffalo, NY; seven grandchildren who brought him immeasurable joy: Michael, Liam, Maeve, Ceili, Aidan, Maren, and Isabella; his sister Gail Alcott (James); Lennon sisters and brothers Liz McCue (Michael), Janice Herrmann (Richard), Thomas (Maria), Mike, Kevin, John, Edward and Sean (dec.); dear friend from

his youth, Dr. Peter Aufmesser and college friends Richmond and Mary Jo Hubbard; along with many beloved nieces and nephews.

His family will receive guests at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, Easton, MD on Sunday, September 1st from 1:00 to 3:00pm. 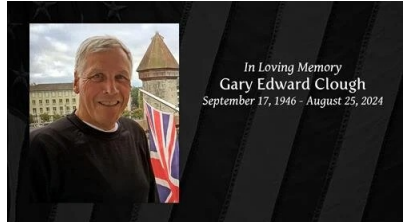
