July 14, 1986 - May 30, 2015

Gary Wayne Hawkins of Stevensville, MD, died on May 30, 2015, surrounded by his loving family at John Hopkins Hospital in Baltimore. He was 28.

He was born on July 14, 1986, at Harbor Hospital in Baltimore, the son of Edward W. Hawkins, Jr. and his wife, Adena, of Covington, VA, and Mary Elizabeth Brown and her husband, Wil, of Baltimore.
