



Gary F. Carlson

March 8, 1934 - July 27, 2008

Gary Field Carlson of Chestertown, MD died on July 27, 2008 at Chester River Hospital Center. He was 74.

Born on March 8, 1934 in Titusville, PA he was the son of the late Arthur DeLayo and Helen Field Carlson. Mr. Carlson graduated from Titusville High School class of 1952. He went on to attend the University of Florida and then enlisted in the U.S. Navy where he served on the U.S.S. WASP before being honorably discharged. Mr. Carlson then returned to Chelmsford, Massachusetts where he worked with Raytheon Corporation for a number of years. He then worked as an engineer with Chrysler Missile Defense in Huntsville, AL, then with Wright-Patterson AFB. He also worked for Systems Research Laboratories as a sales engineer. In 1981 he married Linda Carol Mynes, they then moved to Cherry Hill, NJ. He founded Carlson Enterprise and later co-founded Webb Research. Mr. Carlson is credited with having invented several processes in the plastics industry, which are utilized by several large scale companies. He and his wife moved to Chestertown, MD and started Production Sciences, Inc., making medical connectors and custom parts with distribution to the medical industry both nationally and internationally. Mr. Carlson also served as a consultant. He truly loved problem solving and also enjoyed traveling.

In addition to his wife Linda he is survived by two daughters, Cheryl Carlson of Huntsville, AL and Pamela Taylor of Chestertown, MD; a son, G. Robert Carlson of Sewell, NJ; and sister Nancy Ulf of New London, NH; as well as

grandchildren Kyle, Robert, Brooke and Aaron.
