Gary Lee Redden of Camden, DE died at Kent General Hospital in Dover, DE on Saturday June 7, 2008 after battling a long illness. He was 57.

Born in Chestertown, MD on May 9, 1951 he is the son of the late Harold Redden and June (Elbourn) Severe of Harrington, DE. Mr. Redden was a Signal Supervisor for the Delaware Department of Transportation. He retired after 32 ½ years of service. He was an avid outdoorsman who grew up as a farm boy and that never left him. He enjoyed hunting, fishing & crabbing. He especially enjoyed deer hunting and holds three Delaware Muzzleloader Deer records. He also had an interest in archeology. Mr. Redden was a good man who was wonderful with children; teaching them respect and love for people and the outdoors. He will be remembered for being extremely level headed and calm, strong, independent, intelligent and reliable, his wonderful sense of humor, and being generous with his time, talents and possessions. Mr. Redden was excellent at troubleshooting an issue and had an ability to fix anything. He had an ability to grow anything, like vegetables, flowers and fruit trees. Above all he will be remembered for his devotion to his family and friends.

In addition to his mother, he is survived by his loving wife, Diana G. Redden; a son, Eric J. Redden of Petersburg, VA; two brothers, Roger Redden of Smyrna, DE and James Redden of Harrington, DE; two sisters, Lois Pinson of

Seaford, DE and Nancy Grant of Harrington, DE; as well as his extended family and countless nieces, nephews and beloved friends.

A funeral service will be held on Wednesday June 11, 2008 at Wesley Chapel United Methodist Church in Rock Hall, MD at 10AM, where friends and family may call one hour prior.
